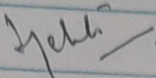
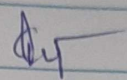
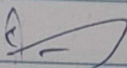


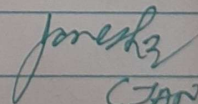
IQAC MEETING - I (SESSION 2023-24)

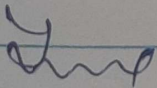

It was decided to adopt a STUDENT CHARTER outlining the responsibility of the institution towards its students and the duties and responsibilities of the students towards the college. It was also decided to incorporate the same in the VISION DOCUMENT of the institution.

The committee approved to expand the scope of ACADEMIC AND CULTURAL LEADERSHIP adopted as one of its best institutional practices to include SOCIAL LEADERSHIP component to enhance the social viability and usefulness of the college vis-à-vis its impact beyond the classroom.

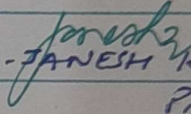

The august committee was appraised about the regular activities being undertaken by the college for overall growth and development of the students. The record of such activities is being maintained separately by concerned committees / subject teachers.

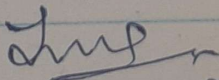

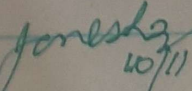
It was communicated to the Committee members that the college proposes to host Inter-college Tae-kwondo championship on 17-19 November.

to accord them an opportunity to interact with students from other colleges of the state. Various modalities of preparing/preparation for successful conduct of the championship were also discussed.

Further deliberations were held about the modus operandi of week-long International Workshop on Brahmi Script to be organized in collaboration with the Dept. of Language and culture, H.P. and H.P. State Museum, Shimla w.e.f. 22-28 November at H.P. State Museum, Shimla. The Committee was informed that this initiative is a part of 'Academic and Cultural Leadership' being adopted as one of its 'Best Institutional Practice' by the college. Students and teachers from various colleges would be trained in reading and deciphering the 'Takri' alphabet/scripts, which is the fundamental script to record our cultural heritage. A cultural fest would also be organized to hone and shape the artistic skills of our students and to honour our students actively participating in activities of social and cultural importance later in the year.

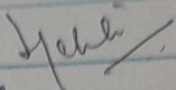
Moreover, like in the previous academic session, liaison with schools of the area would be maintained afresh as a part of academic leadership programme.

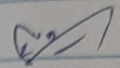
IV - IQAC MEETING (28.02. '2024)

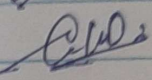
The fourth Annual Meeting of the IQAC, Govt. Degree College Dhomi, Shimla was held on 28.02. 2024 in the office of the Principal. The following members were present:

1. The Committee Expressed concern about the damage to the College Building due to subsidence of land subsequent upon collapse of a private building beneath the college campus due to which a major part of the academic block had to be vacated severely constricting/hindering the functioning of the college activities. The committee was informed in detail about the different measures undertaken by the College administration in this regard.
2. The Committee members were informed that the College had signed a MoU with ELIGO CREATIVE SERVICES PVT. LTD., SHIMLA for Capacity Building of Students on 16.11.'23. However, the activities ensuing from this MoU can be undertaken during the next session only due to damage to the college building.
3. It was, however, noted with a sense of satisfaction that the College has been granted permanent affiliation for its BA and B. Com Courses by HPU, Shimla vide

Notification No. 1-659/2016-HPU(Acad.) dated 16/01/2024.

Temporary Affiliation for running the Science Stream has also been accorded to the College. All necessary equipment for the Science Labs has also been procured.

4. It was decided to restrict the annual Capacity Building Programme for final year students to one-week duration this time as a large part of the college building is currently unusable.
5. It was further decided to restrict the Annual Prize Distribution Function to be held in March 2024 to Prize Dinners only. No guests would be invited from outside. The Annual Report of the College for the Academic Session 2023-24 was also approved.

The Principal thanked all Committee members for their help and cooperation during the entire academic session.
